



LDE/CDE CONTEST AGREEMENT



GENERAL RULES

1. Students will attend 90% of the general FFA meetings.
2. Students must participate in the fundraising activities.
3. Students must be eligible, according to the standard UIL rules, "No Pass No Play," to participate in any contests.
4. LDE and Fall CDE students must be enrolled in a fall Agriculture Science class. CDE, Speaking Events, and Agriscience Fair students must be enrolled in spring Agriculture Science classes.
5. State law prohibits the use of alcoholic beverages, tobacco, narcotic drugs, or controlled substances on any school property and during school trips. All school policies and student code of conduct rules will be in effect.

INVITATIONAL CONTESTS

Student will be responsible for costs incurred of non-qualifying contests.

These costs include:

- Entry fee
- Hotel accommodations

These costs will be divided out amongst the number of team members on each team. For example: \$30/team entry – 4 members/team – Entry costs \$7.50/member

QUALIFYING CONTESTS

District, Area, and State qualifying contests entry fees and hotel accommodations will be paid for by the school district.

We will have signed commitments throughout the year for the students to sign. Commitments to any contest will be treated as an obligation by the student.

Students can accumulate a source of funds through participation of selling items in the fundraisers. They may use a portion of these funds to aid them in paying for contests.
