6. What is a novel or book that you've read for pleasure recently? Why did you choose it?
7. What do you do for fun when you're not studying?
8. What would you do if you won 10 million dollars in the lottery? You can't spend it on yourself.
9. How have you helped someone else, in or out of FFA, when presented with a mentoring opportunity.
10. How has your upbringing shaped your values?
11. You've done some community service. Which service project are you most proud of and why?
12. You have a desire to succeed. Where does this desire come from? Your family, faith or somewhere else?
